



The Better Together Award will give five internationally outstanding collaborations for local climate action the visibility, support and connections to take their impact global.

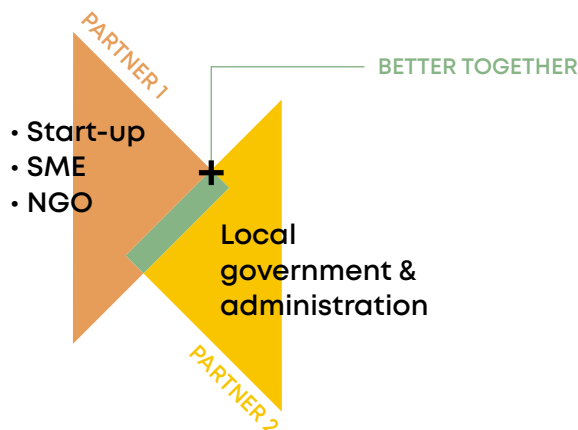

A pioneering award to find the world's best collaborations for climate action

Cities, towns and regions are the pioneering places where local solutions for reducing greenhouse gas emissions and adapting to the effects of climate change need to develop. Meanwhile, start-ups, social enterprises and civil society organisations across the world are exploring and implementing those new ideas. *Better together*, collaborations among both sectors can create the most effective and long-lasting impact for a safe climate future.

Facilitated by Impact Hub Berlin, the **Better Together Award** searches and celebrates the five most impactful collaborations that have implemented such solutions to mitigate or adapt to climate change in their region. The winners will be given the support and connections they need to scale their idea and inspire more climate action worldwide.

Connect & Learn:

Five winning teams will be invited to Europe's start-up hotspot **Berlin** for an intense 5-day **innovation journey** (May 16 – 20, 2019) that will be tailored to their needs. They'll meet renowned urban transition experts, leading climate start-ups and visit Berlin's climate innovation ecosystem.



Pitch & Promote:

Awardees will present their winning idea at the award ceremony of the "International Conference on Climate Action" (ICCA) in **Heidelberg** (May 22 – 23, 2019). Winners will pitch their solution to approx. **1,000 international decision-makers**, exchange on-site and in-depth at the Better Together Marketplace and benefit from our targeted matchmaking with participants.



Expose & Scale:

Last but not least, all ten finalists of the Award will be featured in the Better Together Trend Report as global lighthouse examples for climate adaptation/mitigation. The report will be **widely distributed** to international networks for climate action such as Energy Cities, Climate Alliance or UN Habitat. On top of that, we'll provide winners with **professional video material** from their pitches and a video profile on the award website.
