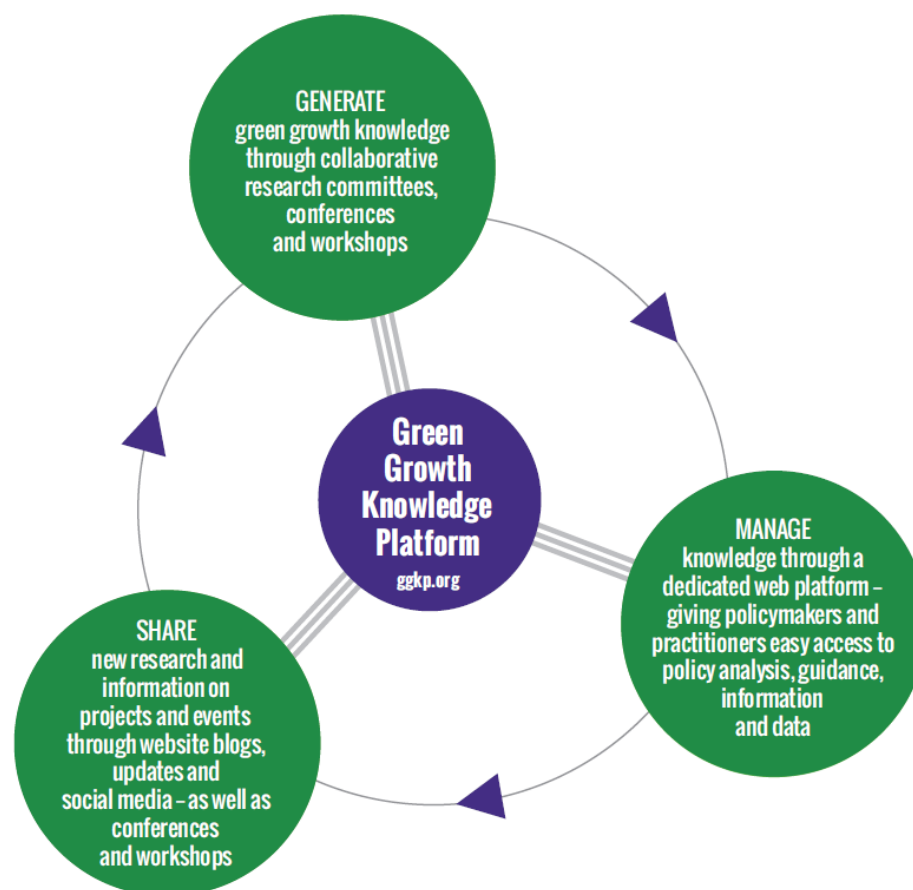


> Un Appel a l'action
